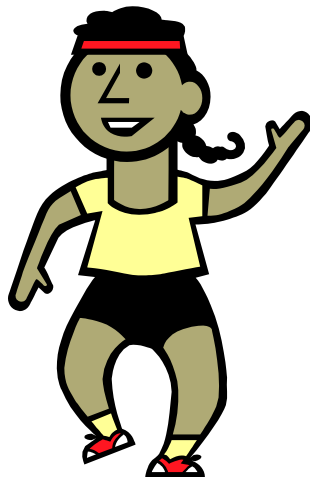


TOUCH RUGBY RESULTS
