HEADS UP FOR KIDS A CAMPAIGN TO COLLECT OLD MONEY AND FOREIGN CURRENCY

Resene Paints and **Lions Clubs** throughout the country are aiming to make a big investment in New Zealand's young people by collecting old banknotes, coins and foreign currency that are not legal tender.

It is estimated by the Reserve Bank that there are millions of dollars in old coins and notes (and foreign currency) that's sitting around in drawers and cupboards in households throughout New Zealand.



The old coins and bank notes can't be used as legal tender; however, they can be redeemed at the Reserve Bank of New Zealand in Wellington - dollar for dollar. The foreign currency will be redeemed in the country of origin through the Lions international network, or sold for scrap. The money isn't worth anything unless it is taken to the Reserve Bank in Wellington, so it does not compete with other fund raising activities.

The "old" money will be invested in New Zealand's most precious asset and provide a springboard for good Kiwi kids to become amazing New Zealanders of the future.

For primary schools, this investment will help teachers train for the Lions Quest programme that offers a year round Life Skills programme for new entrants through to Year 8 or 9.

11,642 teachers from 1550 schools have already been through Lions Quest training and reached over 250,000 students.
